18644. REVIEW OF THE TOWN PLAN BUDGET

The Clerk circulated the latest revision prior to the meeting. It was agreed that the 'Streamside Walk & Footpath 41' project should be named 'Streamside Walk/Footpath 41 & Meadow Brook'.

The Clerk is liaising with Dacorum Borough Council on the sums being carried over to the next financial year.

18645. REVIEW OF THE TOWN PLAN ACTION PLAN

The action plan was reviewed and the following additions made:

- The following sites were suggested as possibly needing a litter bin
 - Dundale 'Green' opposite the school (consider relocating bin on Silk Mill)
 - Grove Road opposite Bunyan Close
- Cllr Hollinghurst explained that widening part of Footpath 41 was included in the Tring, Northchurch & Berkhamsted Urban Transport Plan, but there was no certainty as to its delivery. Resurfacing of the Station Road Cycleway was also in the Urban Transport Plan – resurfacing was in the plans for the next two years work
- Cllr Hollinghurst advised Members on changes in responsibility relating to 'main river', etc. Hertfordshire County Council has responsibility for rainwater run-off and springs whilst Dacorum Borough Council has responsibility for streams and ditches
- The whereabouts of the ANPR equipment purchased by the Town Council was raised
- The Youth Town Council to be invited to attend a Council meeting
- Dacorum Borough Councillors to ask Neil Harvey about crowd funding
- Ask The Friends of Millennium Garden their views on lighting certain trees
