The Council has wide-ranging discretion in determining this application, but key issues that we will consider include (but are not limited to):

- * Obstruction - is there sufficient space in the proposed trading location to accommodate the trader and their proposed structure(s) without causing obstruction or nuisance to other road users? Has permission previously been given for alternate uses of the street which may lead to conflict if this application is granted?
- * Previous experience - has the trader previously been subject to complaints, formal/legal actions, etc as a result of their trading activities?
- * Distinctive product range - is the trader's product range distinctive from that available from existing local businesses in the vicinity of the proposed trading location(s)?
- * Avoiding litter/mess - will the trader ensure that waste is removed from the location and the site tidied or cleaned?
- * Nuisance - will the trader ensure that their activities do not lead to disorder, public nuisance or anti-social behaviour (particularly relevant to later hours trade)?
- * Safety - is there any risk to public safety arising from the proposed activities (including any matters relating to fire safety)?
- * Food safety - if preparing food, have all applicable hygiene/registration requirements been met?
- * Planning - will consent be required (or has this been obtained) for the proposed activities
